

Interclub – FAQ

Q: How do we choose players?

A: Players are chosen based on results from tryouts and past performance as indicated from recent participation in summer interclub competition and the previous winter season. Past performance is the primary factor in determining who is selected for a team. Past performance will be analyzed by the coaches to address a multitude of factors.

The highest level players interested will be selected for a team. If possible, attempts will be made to group players together who want to be on the same team, but level will always take precedent.

Also, when choosing players, consideration will be taken to ensure that there are programs available for all members.

Q: How many players are selected for a team:

A: Each team will have 9 regulars and an unlimited number of spares. For teams enrolled in the Tennis Clubs of Canada Interclub league, spares will be placed in a pool so that all Tennis Clubs of Canada teams can use these spares.

Q: When can spares play?

A: Regular Players are to be used every week. Spares can only be used if regulars are not available.

Q: Which Regular Players play each week?

A: The team will vote on one of the following two options:

Option 1: All Regular Players play the same number of weeks throughout the season.

Option 2: The highest level Regular Players available each week will be scheduled to play. The team's coach will determine the level of play for each player on the team.

Q: Do I have to attend team practices and how do they work?

A: Weekly team practices are strongly encouraged but are not mandatory. The Team will decide on the format of the practice. The Club will offer available days/times for team practices.

Q: Do I need to be available every week as a Regular Player?

A: Regular Players cannot schedule holidays for more than 4 weeks. If a player is to miss more than 4 weeks, he/she can only participate as a spare, not a Regular Player.

Q: Who chooses the weekly lineups?

A: The team will vote on one of the following 3 options:

Option 1: The Captain determines the lineups.

Option 2: The Coach determines the lineups.

Option 3: Both the Captain and the Coach will determine the lineups.

Q: Who chooses the team captain?

A: The players will vote for their captain.
