



## COVID-19 FACILITY GUIDELINES (AS OF MAY 28, 2021)

As the health and safety of all players and staff remains our number one priority, in addition to adhering to the Province of Ontario's "[Framework for Reopening our Province](#)", we will also be referencing the recommendations from the [Ontario Tennis Association](#).

### CLUB STATUS:

Blackmore Tennis Club - OPEN

Marilyn Redvers Tennis Centre – OPEN FOR SUMMER CAMP ONLY (non summer camp play reopens during Step 3 of the Government's "Roadmap to Reopen")

Milton Winter Tennis Club – CLOSED (reopens October 1, 2021)

Newmarket Winter Tennis Club – CLOSED (reopens October 1, 2021)

### PERMITTED ACTIVITIES:

- Casual Play
- Lessons (when we enter Step 1)

### PREPARING TO PLAY:

- Book courts online.
- Clean your equipment, including your racquets and water bottles before each visit.
- Bring Hand Sanitizer.
- Make sure you have enough water before leaving the house.
- Prior to entering the facility, complete an [online self assessment](#). If you exhibit any symptoms, or answer yes to any item on the self assessment, take the province's [self assessment](#) from Ontario.ca. If the result of the assessment indicates that you require a COVID-19 test, or to self isolate, do not enter the facility until you receive medical clearance that it is safe for you to enter the facility.

### ON COURT SAFETY POLICIES:

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- Maintain social distancing of at least 2 meters.
- Avoid touching your face. If you do touch your face, immediately disinfect your hands with hand sanitizer.
- When possible, avoid touching door handles and other objects where the virus could survive. If you touch something, disinfect your hands with your hand sanitizer.
- Unless you live in the same household, do not share food, drinks, towels and equipment with anyone else in the facility.
- If you cough or sneeze, do so in a tissue or in your sleeve.

#### **AFTER PLAYING:**

- Before leaving your court, disinfect your hands with your own hand sanitizer.
- Stop playing at 3 minutes before the end of your court time.
- You should exit the facility immediately upon completion of your court time.
